



Each course consists of 12 sessions (one per week) of 1 hour 15 minutes, except for TOEFL/IELTS, which are 4 sessions (one per week) of 1 hour 15 minutes. UKCAT and BMAT consist of 7 weekly sessions and one full day workshop. A minimum of 3 students is required for a course to be offered.

SAT I can be retaken in a second sitting consisting of 6 sessions. In addition to the 12-session course, practice SAT tests can be taken as often as required.
